### Full Time & Part Time | Sample Programs of Study

The Berry College MBA Program is flexible, and may be completed either full-time or part-time. Below are two sample programs of study. Please note that in both sample cases, all prerequisite courses have been completed. Full Time students enroll in a minimum of 3 courses (9 credit hours) and a maximum of 4 courses (12 credit hours) per semester, while Part Time students enroll in 1 to 2 courses (3 to 6 credit hours) per semester.

For both part-time and full-time programs, a total of 30 credit hours (excluding all proficiency requirements) are required. The 2023-2024 estimated tuition cost per 3 credit course is \$2,160\*. Total Cost of the Program is estimated at \$21,600\*.

Students with Graduate Assistantships follow the part-time, 2-year schedule.

Classes meet once each week from 6:00pm - 8:45pm. During the summer semester, classes meet in five-week blocks with each class meeting twice per week from 6:00pm - 9:30pm.
