The center also hosts key programs like Berry Impact and the Bonner Scholars Program, further integrating the student experience with Berry's Good Neighbor Culture."

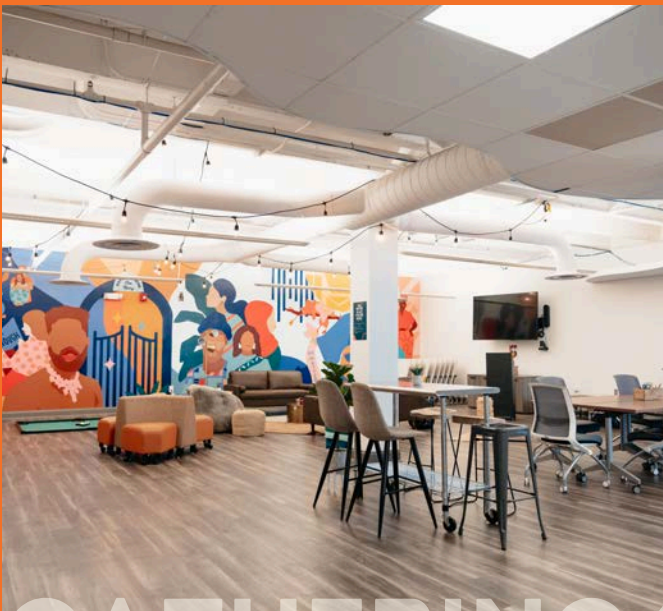
